Barbara A. Conley, MD has been Associate Director of the Cancer Diagnosis Program (CDP) in the NCI Division of Cancer Treatment and Diagnosis (DCTD) since 2010. She is also a member of the Division's experimental therapeutics clinic. Her previous positions at the Institute included Senior Investigator in Cancer Therapy and Evaluation Program Clinical Investigations Branch, and Chief of the Cancer Diagnosis Program Diagnostics Research Branch, as well as Head, Aerodigestive Diseases in the intramural medicine branch. Immediately prior to her current appointment at DCTD, she was Chief of Division of Hematology/Oncology at Michigan State University (MSU). She was a member of the faculty at the University of Maryland from 1987-1997. Dr. Conley has been the principal investigator on several NCI grants or contracts.

Dr. Conley holds an undergraduate degree from the University of Michigan and received her MD from Michigan State University. She is board-certified in Internal Medicine and Medical Oncology, and has research interests in diagnostic markers, drug development, and cancers of the aerodigestive tract. She has published extensively in many journals, including the *Journal of Clinical Oncology*, *Clinical Cancer Research* and *Nature Medicine*, and is on the editorial board of several professional publications.
