



Dr. Jennifer Hayes is a Program Director in the National Cancer Institute (NCI) Coordinating Center for Clinical Trials (CCCT), which is responsible for implementing and facilitating the NCI Clinical Trials Working Group Report initiatives and the restructuring of the National Clinical Trials Network. As a CCCT Program Director, Dr. Hayes oversees the Breast Cancer Steering Committee and the Cancer Clinical Investigator Team Leadership Awards Program. She has also overseen the Symptom Management and Health-Related Quality of Life Steering Committee and has organized NCI meetings on the *Next Generation Trials for HER-2-positive Breast Cancer* and *Building Bridges: the Identification of Core Symptoms and Health-Related Quality of Life Domains for use in Cancer Research*.

Dr. Hayes joined the NCI in 2010, after several years as a Program Manager and Scientific Program Officer at the Department of Defense (DoD) Congressionally Directed Medical Research Programs, where she worked with the Breast Cancer, Autism, and Chronic Myelogenous Leukemia Research Programs. Prior to the DoD, she worked as a Research Associate in the Life Sciences Sector at JP Morgan Chase.

Dr. Hayes has a Ph.D. in Cell Biology and Genetics from Cornell University with post-doctoral research experience in Immunology at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center. She graduated from Rutgers University with a B.A. in Biological Sciences.
