



Robert J. Nordstrom, PhD has been a program director in the Cancer Imaging Program of NCI since 2006. Prior to that, he served as a Scientific Review Administrator for the Center for Scientific Review of NIH beginning in 2002. Before government service, Nordstrom was Vice President of Research for MediSpectra, a company perfecting optical technology to assist in the detection of cervical neoplasia. His PhD is from The Ohio State University (1974) for nonlinear laser spectroscopy in physics. He is the author of over 40 peer reviewed publications, two book chapters and nine patents. Nordstrom serves as an associate editor for the Biomedical Optics

Express journal of the Optical Society of America and organizes an annual conference on optical phantoms for biomedical applications at the Photonics West Symposium held in San Francisco, CA.
